

**LAWS AND REGULATIONS**

PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION OF 13 JULY 1931 FOR
LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, AS
AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 11 DECEMBER 1946

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

ARRETE

For the addition to the narcotic drugs in Schedule I appended to Decree Law No. 351 of 1952 relative to the control of narcotics, regulating use thereof and trade therein:

Minister of Public Health,

Considering Article 32 of Decree Law No. 351 of 1952 regarding the control of narcotics, regulating use thereof and trade therein, modified by Laws Nos.: 153 and 345 of 1953, and

Considering Arrêtés dated December 9, 1953, March 8, 1954, March 9, 1954 and May 1, 1954, modifying Schedule I appended to the said Decree Law, and

The proposal of the Director-General of the Technical Inspection Department,

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Article I: The following drugs shall be added after item 30 in Schedule I appended to Decree Law No. 351 of 1952 referred to:-

- (31) 4-Morpholino-2,2-diphenyl ethyl butyrate and its salts;
- (32) 4,4-diphenyl-6-piperidino-3-heptanone (Piperidyl amidone) and its salts;
- (33) Isopropyl ester of 1-methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid and its salts;
- (34) Dihydrohydroxymorphinone and its salts;
- (35) Myristyl ester of benzylmorphine and its salts;
- (36) 4,4-Diphenyl-6-dimethylamino-3-hexanone and its salts;
- (37) Beta-4,4-diphenyl-6-dimethylamino-3-heptanol and its salts;
- (38) 6-Methyldihydromorphine and its salts.

Article II: This Arrêté shall come into force as from date of its publication in the Official Journal.
