THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1952

(No. 30 of 1952)¹⁾

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS REGULATIONS, 1952

(L.N. 555 of 1952)²⁾

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 7, 16 and 47 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1952, and other powers him enabling the High Commissioner in Council hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the DANGEROUS DRUGS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1956.
2. Part I of the Third Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Regulations, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations), is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) by substituting for item 13 under the heading Morphine Preparations the item following:

"13. Pilulae digitalis et Opii compositae-Digitalis leaves, in powder 0.31 g., Opium in powder 0.19 g., Ipecacuanha root, in powder 0.13 g., Quinine Sulphate 0.78 g., Syrup of Glucose, a sufficient quantity to make 12 pills.";
 - (b) by substituting for item 14 under the heading Morphine Preparations the item following:

"14. Pilulae hydrargyri cum Opio-Mercury Pill 3.89 g., Opium, in powder 0.19 g., to make 12 pills.";
 - (c) by substituting for item 16 under the heading Morphine Preparations the item following:

"16. Pilulae Ipecacuanha cum Scilla-Compound powder of Ipecacuanha 1.56 g., Squill, in powder 0.52 g., Ammoniacum, in powder 0.52 g., Syrup of Liquid Glucose, a sufficient quantity to make 12 pills.";
 - (d) by substituting for item 28 under the heading Morphine Preparations the item following:

"28. Tabella hydrargyri cum Opio-Mercurous Chloride powder 0.065 g., Antimony Oxide powder 0.065 g., Ipecacuanha-root powder 0.065 g., Powdered Opium 0.065 g., Milk Sugar 0.065 g., gelatin solution, a sufficient quantity to make 1 tablet.";

(e) by deleting the full stop at the end of item 30 under the heading Morphine Preparations and by adding the words, figures and punctuation "to make 100 tablets."; and

(f) by substituting for item 5 under the heading Cocaine Preparations the item following:

"5. Cocaine and Atropine tablets - Cocaine and atropine tablets with a content of not more than 0.0003 g. of cocaine salts and not less than 0.0003 g. of atropine salts to each tablet. Atropinum Sulphuricum 0.0003 g., Cocainum Hydrochloricum 0.0003 g., Mannite 0.003 g., Weight of one tablet 0.0036 g., Cocaine content 8.3 per cent.".

3. Part II of the Third Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:

(a) by substituting for the last item the item following:

"Methylmorphine, ethylmorphine, morpholinylethylmorphine [Pholcodine]³⁾ and their respective salts and any preparation, admixture or other substance containing any proportion of methylmorphine, ethylmorphine or morpholinylethylmorphine associated with an inert substance whether solid or liquid; and preparations, admixtures or other substances containing more than 2.5 per cent. of methylmorphine, ethylmorphine or morpholinylethylmorphine (calculated as pure drug) associated with other medicinal substances."; and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the item following:

"Any preparation, admixture or other substance containing any proportion of dihydrocodeine or its salts.".

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1952

(No. 30 of 1952)¹⁾

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11 and 17 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") the High Commissioner in Council hereby makes the Order following:

2. This Order may be cited as the DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDER, 1956.

3. The provisions of sub-section (1) of section 17 of the Ordinance shall not apply to the following drugs, their salts, any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of the drugs or their salts:

"15. Alphameprodine (alpha-4-propiony-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine) [$\overline{\alpha}$ -1-methyl-3-ethyl-4-phenyl-4-propiony-piperidine]

"; and

(e) by adding immediately after item 16 the item following:

"17. The following drugs, their salts, any preparation, admixture, extract or other substances containing any proportion of the drugs or their salts -
