### **NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

RULES

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (RAW OPIUM) RULES, 1951.

Short title.

Possession  
of raw  
opium, etc.

1. These rules may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Raw Opium) Rules, 1951.
2. (1) Any person found in possession of raw opium, coca leaves or Indian hemp shall be guilty of an offence against this rule and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £150 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month.  
(2) For the purposes of this rule a person shall be deemed to be in possession if the raw opium, coca leaves or Indian hemp is in his actual custody or is held by any other person subject to his control or for him or on his behalf.

Made by the Governor in Council this 18th day of October, 1951, under the authority of Section 4A of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance.

DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 33 of the Revised Edition, 1950)

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by subsection (3) of Section 9 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, the Governor hereby declares that Part III of the Ordinance shall apply to the following:-

Dihydrocodeine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dihydrocodeine.

Acetyldihydrocodeine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of acetyldihydrocodeine.

4-Propionoxy-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 4-propionoxy-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine.

3-Hydroxy-N-methylmorphinan, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-hydroxy-N-methylmorphinan.

Made by the Governor this 18th day of October, 1951.
