AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE (Cap. 33)

No. 20 of 1960

ENACTED by the Governor of Gibraltar with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance, Short title.
- 2. Section $4\lambda^{1/2}$ of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance is amended by deleting Amendment subsection (2).
