NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL-- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 33)

PROCLAMATION

(No. 9 of 1956)

By His Excellency JOHN GUTCH, ESQUIRE,

Whereas by subsection (2) of section 13 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance power is conferred upon the High Commissioner by Proclamation to apply Part 111 of that Ordinance to any drug of whatever kind, which is, or is likely to be, or which is capable of being, changed into any drug which is, or is likely to be, productive, if improperly used, of ill effects substantially of the same character or nature as, or analogous to, those produced by morphine or cocaine.

And whereas it appears to me that the drugs specified in the Schedule hereto are capable of being changed into drugs which are, or are likely to be, productive, if improperly used, of ill effects substantially of the same character or nature as, or analogous to, those produced by morphine or cocaine.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the above power I hereby apply Part 111 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance to the drugs specified in the Schedule hereto.

Given under my hand and the Seal of the Western Pacific High Commission at Honiara this Twenty-eighth day of August 1956.

SCHEDULE

1,3-dimethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionyhexamethyleneimine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 1,3-dimethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionyhexamethyleneimine.

3-hydroxy-N-phenethylmorphinan, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-hydroxy-N-phenethylmorphinan.

4-morpholino-2,2-diphenyl ethyl butyrate, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 4-morpholino-2,2-diphenyl ethyl butyrate.

4-dimethylamino-1,2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionybutane, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 4-dimethylamino-1,2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionybutane.
