DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 134)

DANGEROUS DRUGS (AMENDMENT OF FIRST SCHEDULE) (NO. 2) ORDER, 1961

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, the Governor in Council has made the following order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment of First Schedule) (No. 2) Order, 1961.
2. Part I of the First Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance) is amended by the deletion of items 17 and 18.
3. Part II of the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance is amended by the addition after item 3 of the following new items:

- "4. Propoxyphene^{1/} (4-dimethylamino-1,2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionoxybutane)

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the Order but intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this Order is to transfer from Part I of the First Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance to Part II of the First Schedule the drugs acetyldihydrocodeine dihydrocodeine, and to add to Part II of the Schedule the drug propoxyphene (4-dimethylamino-1,2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionoxybutane) [4-dimethylamino-3-methyl-1,2-diphenyl-2-propionoxybutane].
