NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE. (Chapter 134).

Dangerous Drugs (Amendment of Schedule) Order, 1955.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, the Governor in Council has made the following order-

Citation.

1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment of Schedule) Order, 1955.

Amendment of the First Schedule to the Ordinance (Cap. 134).

- 2. This First Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance is amended by the deletion of the drugs specified therein and included as item No. 28 and the substitution therefor of the following-
- "28. 3-Methoxy-N-methylmorphinan other than dextromethorphan but including levomethorphan and racemethorphan, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-Methoxy-N-methylmorphinan".
