LAWS AND REGULATIONS

PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL TREATIES ON NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES

PHARMACY AND POISONS(AMENDMENT) REGULATION 1992

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section 29 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138), subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board by notice in the Gazette.

Substances falling within the Poisons List to which special restrictions apply under regulations 3 and 5

Part A of the First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) is amended-

(a) in the item of Alkaloids by repealing "Codeine, except substances containing less than 1.5% of codeine" and substituting-

"Codeine, except substances containing not more than 0.1% of codeine"; and

(b) by repealing "Methorphan: its salts: its optical isomers: their salts: except substances containing less than 1.5% of dextromethorphan" and substituting-

Explanatory Note

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations is a list of substances to which special sale restrictions apply. This Regulation amends that Schedule to tighten control on sale of cough medicine containing more than 0.1% of codeine or dextromethorphan.
