#### BOMBAY PROHIBITION ACT, 1949<sup>1)</sup>

No. OPM 1056. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 49 and 143 of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949 (Bom. XXV of 1949), and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Bombay hereby amends the Bombay Opium Rules, 1953<sup>2)</sup>, as follows, namely: -

In rule 2 of the said rules, in sub-rule (1), in sub-clause (ii) of clause (i), after the figures "1938" the following shall be added, namely: -

"or a person exempted from the provisions of section 32 of that Act by virtue of a notification issued under the proviso to sub-section (1) of the said section 32"

BOMBAY PROHIBITION ACT, 1949<sup>1)</sup>

No. OPM. 1056 (a). - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 143 of the Bombay Prohibition Act, 1949 (Bom. XXV of 1949), and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Bombay hereby amends the Bombay Ganja and Bhang Rules, 1953<sup>3)</sup>, as follows, namely: -

In rule 2 of the said rules, in sub-rule (1), in sub-clause (ii) of clause (h), after the figures "1938" the following shall be added, namely: -

"or a person exempted from the provisions of section 32 of that Act by virtue of a notification issued under the proviso to sub-section (1) of the said section 32".

ORDER

BOMBAY DANGEROUS DRUGS RULES, 1935

No. DDR. 1056. - In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 25-A of the Bombay Dangerous Drugs Rules, 1935, the Government of Bombay, hereby authorises -

(i) the Director of Veterinary Services, Bombay State, Poona,

(ii) the Divisional Veterinary Officers, and

(iii) the Government Officers in charge of the Government Veterinary dispensaries in the pre-Reorganisation State of Bombay, excluding the transferred territories,

to possess on behalf of Government, the following manufactured drugs required for use in the course of their official duties, namely: -

(a) Pulvis Opii;

(b) Tincture Opii;

(c) Cocaine Hydrochloride.

ORDER

BOMBAY DANGEROUS DRUGS RULES, 1935.

No. DDR. 1056. - In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 25-A of the Bombay Dangerous Drugs Rules, 1935, the Government of Bombay, hereby authorizes -

- (1) the Director of Veterinary Services, Bombay State, Poona.
- (2) the Divisional Veterinary Officers, and
- (3) the Government Officers-in-charge of the Government Veterinary Dispensaries,

in the pre-Reorganised State of Bombay. excluding the transferred territories, to possess on behalf of Government, the manufactured drug called "Opium Pulveratum" required by them for use in the course of their official duties.
