Notification

In virtue of the powers conferred on him by rule 37 of the Madras Manufactured Drugs Rules, 1932, published with Revenue Department Notification No. 203, dated the 29th April 1932, at pages 798-806 of Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated the 3rd May 1932, as subsequently amended, the Commissioner of Excise and Prohibition hereby makes the following amendment to the rules for the issue of licences in Forms M-1 and M-2 under the Madras Manufactured Drugs Rules, published at pages 110-112 of Rules Supplement to Part II of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated the 20th August, 1952, as subsequently amended:—

Amendment

In the said rules, in rule 5, for the words "through the District Prohibition Officer or the District Superintendent of Police, as the case may be", the words "through the Inspector of Excise" shall be substituted.
