NOTIFICATION. DANGEROUS DRUGS.

No. 7 - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(1) of section 3 of the Opium Act, 1857 (XIII of 1857), and in supersession of the Ministry of Finance (Revenue Division) Notifications No. 2-Opium, dated the 18th March 1950, and 10-Opium, dated the 30th December, 1950, the Central Government hereby appoints the Narcotics Commissioner as Opium Agent to superintend the provision of opium for the Central Government in Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Bharat and Rajasthan.
