NOTIFICATION MISCELLANEOUS

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 40 and 75 of the U.P. Excise Act, 1910 (U.P. Act No. IV of 1910), read with the U.P. General Clauses Act, 1904 (U.P. Act No. 1 of 1904), the Governor of Uttar Pradesh is pleased to extend, with effect from April 1, 1956, the U.P. Intoxicant Prohibition Rules, 1947¹⁾ as contained in Chapter XII of the Excise Manual U.P., Volume I, to all the districts of Uttar Pradesh so far as these rules relate to the sale, transport import, export and possession of Ganja / Cannabis /2)
