NOTIFICATION DANGEROUS DRUGS

No. 9-. In pursuance of clause (a) of rule 2 of
the Central Opium Rules, 1934, the Central Govern-
ment hereby directs that the following amendments
shall be made in the notification of the Government
of India in the Ministry of Finance (Revenue
Division), No. S.R.O. 2607 dated the 14th August,
1954, namely:-

In the Schedule to the said notification-

(1) In Part I-

(a) in the entries relating to the Faizabad Opium
Circle, the entry "Basti" under the Column

headed "District" and the entry "Amroha"
under the column headed "Extent"
Tehsil/Pargana

shall be omitted;

(b) after the Shahjahanpur Opium Circle and the
entries relating thereto, the following shall
be added, namely:-

"Experimental
Farm attached Ghazipur Ghazipur:"
to the Govern-
ment Opium Factory,
Ghazipur.

(2) In Part II. to the entries relating to the Ratlam
Opium Circle, the entry "Shajapur" under the
column headed "District" and the entry "Agar and
Susner" under the column headed "Extent"
Tehsil/Pargana

shall be added.
