PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF
THE INTERNATIONAL TREATIES ON NARCOTIC DRUGS

IRAQ

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL - In accordance with the relevant Articles of the International Treaties on Narcotic Drugs, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

In accordance with the decision of the Director-General of the World Health Organization, communicated by the United Nations Secretariat, under Art.11, paragraph 5 of the Convention for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs of 1931, which states that the two items, listed below, may cause addiction and should therefore be placed under control, as provided in the above Convention; and in view of our authority under Article 11 paragraph c, and Article XII of Law No.44 of 1938, on Dangerous and Intoxicating Drugs; we decide that the following two items should be added to Section (a) of Group (I) of Schedule (I) annexed to the above-mentioned Law:

1. 4, 4-diphenyl-6-piperidine-3-hexanone(Norpipanone)^{1/} and its salts
2. 1-phenethyl-4-N-propionylanilinopiperidine (Fentanyl)

This notice shall enter into force upon publication in the Official Gazette.
