THE DANGEROUS DRUGS LAW, 1942
(Law 22 of 1942)
THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (APPLICATION) ORDER, 1950

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by subsection (3) of section 10 of the Dangerous Drugs Law, 1942, and by section 26 and section 3 of the Interpretation Law, 1943, the following Order is hereby made: -

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Application) Order, 1950.
2. It is hereby declared that Part IV of the Dangerous Drugs Law, 1942, shall apply to the following drugs:-
 - (i) Alphaprodine (-4-Propionoxy-4-phenyl-1: 3-dimethyl-4-piperidine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of alphaprodine;
 - (ii) Amidone (6-Dimethylamino-4: 4-diphenylheptan-3-one), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of amidone;
 - (iii) Betaprodine(-4-Propionoxy-4-phenyl-1:3-dimethyl-4-piperidine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of betaprodine;
 - (iv) Hydroxypethidine (Ethyl 4-m-hydroxyphenyl-1-methyl-piperidine-4-carboxylate), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of hydroxypethidine;
 - (v) Isoamidone (6-Dimethylamino-4:4 diphenyl-5-methyl-hexan-3-one), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of isoamidone;
 - (vi) Ketobemidone (4-Propionyl-4-m-hydroxyphenyl-1-methyl-piperidine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of ketobemidone;
 - (vii) Methadol (6-Dimethylamino-4:4-diphenylheptan-3-ol), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methadol;
 - (viii) Methadyl acetate (6-Dimethylamino-4: 4-diphenyl-3-heptyl acetate), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methadyl acetate;
 - (ix) Phenadoxone (6-Morpholino-4:4-diphenylhaptan-3-one), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of phenadoxone.
3. Paragraph 2 of the Dangerous Drugs (Application) (No. 2) Order, 1948, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of sub-paragraphs (i) and (iii).
