NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL-- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

CABINET ORDER No.22

promulgated on 20 March 1957

PARTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CABINET ORDER FOR DESIGNATING NARCOTIC DRUGS

In pursuance of the provision of the Annex, No.23, of the Narcotic Control Law (Law No.14 of 1953)^{1/}, the Cabinet enacts the present Cabinet Order.

The Cabinet Order for designating narcotic drugs (Cabinet Order No.22 of 1954)^{2/} has been partially amended as follows:

Next to Item No.17, the following two items are added:

18. ~~1-methyl-3-ethyl-4-phenyl-4-propionoxypiperidine~~ [alphameprodine]^{3/} and its salts.
19. 1-(2-(p-aminophenyl)-ethyl)-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester [anileridine] and its salts.

Supplementary provisions:

The present Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day when 30 days have passed reckoning from the day of its promulgation.
