PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION OF 13 JULY 1981 FOR LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, AS AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 11 DECEMBER 1946

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

> CABINET ORDER NO. 170 FOR PARTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CABINET ORDER FOR THE SPECIFICATION OF NARCOTICS

In accordance with the provisions of No. 23 of the Annexed List of the Narcotic Control Law (Law No. 14 of 1953), - the Cabinet enacts this Cabinet Order.

The Cabinet Order for the Specification of Narcotics (Cabinet Order No. 22 of 1954) 2 shall be partially amended as follows:

The following two items shall be added after No. 23:

- Normorphine $\frac{3}{2}$ and its salts.

Supplementary Provision:

This Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day when thirty days have elapsed reckoning from the day of its promulgation.
