NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL - In accordance with the relevant Articles of the International Treaties on Narcotic Drugs, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

CABINET ORDER NO. 306

to amend the Cabinet Order for Designating Narcotic Drugs

7 August 1972

The Cabinet, in accordance with paragraph 53 of the Annexed List of the Narcotics Control Law, $\underline{1}$ enacts this Cabinet Order.

The Cabinet Order for Designating Narcotic Drugs (Cabinet Order No. 327, 1963)2/ shall be amended as follows:

The following new paragraph shall be added to Article 2.

9. N-(1-methyl-2-piperidinoethyl)

-N-2-pyridylpropionamide and its salts [propiram] 3/

Supplementary Provision

This Cabinet Order shall come into force on the date after a lapse of 30 days reckoning from the date of its promulgation.
