"The Government of Japan has periodically submitted reports on the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights in conformity with part IV of the Covenant (E/1982/3/Add.7, E/1984/6/Add.6 and Corr.1, E/1986/3/Add.4 and Corr.1). These reports reflect the 'policies for the implementation, promotion and protection of economic, social and cultural rights', on which it is invited to comment in paragraph 6 of the Commission on Human Rights resolution 1986/15. The Government of Japan, therefore, does not consider it necessary to duplicate the information contained in the above-mentioned reports and requests those who are interested to refer to them."
