The Minister of Social Affairs and Public Health,

Having regard to the Order of 24 February 1958, No. 1685*/, Department of Public Health, Division of Health Protection ("Staatscourant" 48)(1);

Considering article 2, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph g, and article 6, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph a, of the Opium Act ("Staatsblad" 1928, 167)(2);

Hereby orders as follows:

SOLE ARTICLE

In the Order of 24 February 1958, No. 1685, Department of Public Health, Division of Health Protection, the following narcotic drugs shall be added in article 1, paragraph 3:

Allylprodine **/ 3-allyl-1-methyl-4-phenyl-4-propienexypiperidine, C H 0 N and its salts;
