# MINISTRY OF SOCIAL AFFAIRS SUPPLEMENT TO THE DECREE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF SECTION 2,

UNDER 1, G, OF THE OPIUM ACT

In consideration of Section 2, under 1, g, of the Opium Act (Staatsblad 1928, No. 167), amended by the Act of 28 July 1933 (Staatsblad No. 381); In view of his decree of 8 December 1933, No. 1762 P, as amended, for the enforcement of the said section of the aforementioned Act;

Has deemed it fitting

to supplement the said decree by adding to the substances, listed under figure 2: 4,4-diphenyl -6- dimethylaminoheptanon -3 and its salts (such as amidone, methadon, symoron).
