## THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE (Cap. 74, Revised Edition, 1933)

## NOTICE

(Under Section 2 of the Ordinance)

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ACTING GOVERNOR has been pleased to declare the following substances to be drugs within the meaning of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance:-

(a) Amidone (dl-2-dimethylamino-4 : 4-diphenylheptane-5-one), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of amidone.

(b) Methyldihydromorphinone (commonly known as Metopon), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methyldihydromorphinone.

## THE PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Ordinance No. 3 of 1941)

#### ORDER

(Under Section 20 (4) of The Ordinance)

1. This Order may be cited as the Poisons List (Confirmation) (Amend-G.N. No. 49 ment) Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Poisons List (Confirmof 1942 ation) Order, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Paragraph 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition at the end of Part I thereof of the following poisons:-

"dl-2-dimethylamino-4 : 4-diphenylheptane-5-one; its salts; Methyldihydromorphinone; its salts."
