SECOND OPIUM CONFERENCE.

Resolution passed at a meeting held in Edinburgh on November 7th, 1924, under the auspices of the following societies:-

League of Nations Union,
National Council of Women,
Edinburgh Women Citizens Association,
Women's Co-operative Guilds,
National Vigilance Association.

(Circulated by the Secretary of the Second Opium Conference at the request of these Societies).

"That this Meeting believes that the principle should be recognised by the Government of India and by the British Government in respect of all British dependences and Protectorates that the export and import of opium whether raw or prepared, except for medicinal or scientific purposes, be reduced over a period of ten years till it is entirely prohibited."
