LAWS AND REGULATIONS

PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION OF 13 JULY 1931 FOR LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, AS AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 11 DECEMBER 1946

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL -- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

GOVERNOR SECRETARIAT, EAST BENGAL EAST BENGAL REGULATION No. 1 of 1954

A REGULATION

to control the practice of smoking prepared opium in Chittagong Hill-tracts.

Ben. Act, X of 1932 Regulation I of 1900

WHEREAS it is expedient to control the practice of smoking prepared opium in Chittagong Hill-tracts and for that purpose to apply thereto the Bengal Opium Smoking Act, 1932, and also to amend the Chittagong Hill-tracts Regulation, 1900

AND WHEREAS by sub-section (2) of section 92 of the Government of India Act, 1935, the Governor is empowered to make regulation for the peace and good government of any area in his province which is for the time being an excluded area or a partially excluded area:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor of East Bengal, in exercise of the said powers and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, is pleased to make the following Regulations:-

1. (1) This Regulation may be called Short title and the Chittagong Hill-tracts Opium Smoking Regulations, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. The Bengal Opium Smoking Act, 1932, shall apply to the Chittagong Hilltracts subject to the following amendment, namely;-

Sub-section (2) and (3) of section I shall be omitted.

3. In section 13 of the Chittagong Hill-tracts Regulation 1900, after subsection (2) the following sub-section shall be added, namely:-

"(3) Nothing in sub-section (1) and (2) shall apply to or in respect of "Prepared opium" as defined in the Bengal Opium Smoking Act, 1932". commencement.
