ACT OF 21 MAY 1963 ON POISONOUS SUBSTANCES

Article 21

The following changes are hereby made in the Act of 8 January 1951^{1/} on pharmaceutical products, narcotic drugs and medical appliances (Dziennik Ustaw No. 1, Item 4):

(1) Item (g) is deleted from article 5, paragraph 1, the following items (h) to (s) henceforth being numbered (g) to (r);

(2) The words "in agreement, so far as they permit the manufacture or conversion of ethyl ether, with the Minister of Agricultural and Consumer Industries" are deleted from article 18, paragraph 1.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL WELFARE

11 December 1962 (TM.020/76/62)

on internal statistical reporting work in
provincial pharmacy administrations in 1963

Having regard to article 13, paragraph 2, of the Act of 15 February 1962 on the organization of official statistics (Dziennik Ustaw No. 10, Item 47), it is ordered as follows:

1. Provincial pharmacy administrations shall assemble and record statistical data on the forms and within the time-limits indicated in the list annexed to this Order.
2. The reporting forms to be used in 1963 shall be those registered at the Chief Statistical Office under Nos. 91/VIII/87 to 91/VIII/98.
3. The Ministry of Health and Social Welfare (Pharmaceutical Department and Planning and Budgetary Department) shall supply statistical reporting forms to the provincial pharmacy administrations together with detailed instructions for completing and returning them.
4. In accordance with article 20, paragraphs 1 and 2, of the Act of 15 February 1962 on the organization of official statistics (Dziennik Ustaw No. 10, Item 47), persons who, although required to do so, fail to prepare statistical reports or prepare them incorrectly or after the expiry of the stipulated time-limit shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 1,000 zlotys. Persons who prepare statistical reports according to instructions but on forms not approved by the Director of the Chief Statistical Office shall be liable to the same fine.
5. This Order shall enter into force on the day of its publication with effect from 1 January 1963.

Article 6, paragraph 3

Prescriptions for antibiotics and narcotic drugs must be filled within fourteen days of the date of their issue.
