In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

POLAND

Order of the Minister of Health of 31 May 1950
amending the Order of the Minister of Social Security designating certain
narcotic substances and products as having harmful effects on health.

In virtue of article 1 of the Act of 22 June 1923 concerning narcotic substances and products (Official Gazette of the Polish Republic No. 72, item 559), the following order is hereby made in agreement with the Minister of Heavy Industry and the Minister of Internal Trade:

1. The Order of the Minister of Social Security of 19 June 1937 designating certain narcotic substances and products as having harmful effects on health (Official Gazette of the Polish Republic, 1937, No. 49, item 379 and 1948, No. 9, item 62) shall be amended as follows:

Add to paragraph 1 a sub-paragraph (o) reading as follows:

"(o) Methyldihydromorphinone and its salts (metopon and its salts)".

2. This Order shall come into force on the day of its promulgation.
