Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931, for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of the United Kingdom.

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1926

(No. 10 of 1926)

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDER IN COUNCIL - 1947

WHEREAS it appears to the Governor in Council that the drugs specified in the Schedule hereto are productive, if improperly used or are capable of being converted into a substance which is or is likely to be productive, if improperly used, of ill effects substantially of the same character or nature as or analogous to those produced by morphine or cocaine.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor in Council by subsection (2) of section 13 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1926, His Excellency is pleased by and with the advice of the Executive Council to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs Order in Council, 1947. Ordinance No. 10 of 1926, section 13 (2)
Short title.
2. Part V of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1926 shall apply to the Drugs specified in the Schedule hereto in the same manner as it applies to the drugs mentioned in subsection (1) of section 13 of the said Ordinance. Application of Part V of Ordinance No. 10 of 1926 to certain drugs.

SCHEDULE

Dihydrodesoxymorphine (commonly known as desomorphine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dihydrodesoxymorphine.

Pethidine (1 methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of pethidine.

Any preparation, not being a preparation capable of external use only, made from extract or tincture of Indian Hemp.
