THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE (Cap. 58)

The Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Order in Council, 1955

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by subsection (2) of section 13 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Order in Council, 1955.

2. The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Order in Council, (as amended by the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Order in Council, 1953), is hereby amended by the deletion of the following—

"3-Methoxy-N-methylmorphinan (that is to say, dextromethorphan, levomethorphan and racemethorphan), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-methoxy-N-methylmorphinan." and the substitution therefor of the following-

"3-Methoxy-N-methylmorphinan other than dextromethorphan (that is to say, levomethorphan and racemethorphan) its salts and any preparation admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-methoxy-N-methylmorphinan.".

3. The Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Order in Council 1953, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

The effect of this Order is to remove the drug known as dextromethorphan from the Second Schedule to the principal Order in Council.
