THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (APPLICATION OF SECTION 17) ORDER, 1955.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 (1) and (2) of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1951, the Minister for Health hereby makes the following Order: —

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Application of section 17) Order, 1955.

2. The Minister hereby directs that subsection (1) of section 17 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1951, shall cease to apply to the following products: —

Methyl-desomorphine (6-methyl- Δ^6 -desoxymorphine)
Diacetyl-N-allylnormorphine.

3. The Minister hereby declares that the provisions of Part IV of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1951, shall apply to the following product: —
Methyl-desomorphine (6-methyl- Δ^6 -desoxymorphine).

THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (EXEMPTION) ORDER, 1955.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 44 (a) (i) of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1951, the Minister for Health hereby makes the following Order: —

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Exemption) Order, 1955.
2. The Minister hereby exempts the following drugs from the provisions of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1951: —

Dextromethorphan,
Dextrorphan,
Nalorphine, and their respective salts.
