THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1934

Supplement II, page 118,

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 4 (2) of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1934, I, Gerald Thomas Fisher, Brigadier, Companion of the Most Exalted Order of the Star of India, Companion of the Most Eminent Order of the Indian Empire, Military Governor of the Somaliland Protectorate, do hereby declare that Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1934, shall after the 15th day of March, 1948, apply to the following drugs:

Amidone (d1-2-dimethylamino-4: 4-diphenylheptane-5-one), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of amidone;

Methyldihydromorphinone. (commonly known as Metopon), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methyldihydromorphinone;

Dihydrodesoxymorphine (commonly known as desomorphine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of Dihydrodesoxmorphine; and

Pethidine (1 methyl -4- phenylpiperidine -4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of pethidine,

in the same manner as the said Part III applies to the drugs mentioned in sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1934
