Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of the United Kingdom.

GOVERNMENT NOTICE

No. 379.] [2nd May, 1947.

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Internal Affairs has been pleased, in terms of section 12 of the Dangerous Drugs Act (Chapter 146), to make the following regulations:

The Schedule to the Dangerous Drugs Act (Chapter 146) is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following paragraphs:

- "(m) Dihydrodesoxymorphine (commonly known as Desomorphine), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dihydrodesoxymorphine.
- (n) Pethidine (1 methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester), its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract, or other substance containing any proportion of pethidine."

Government Notice No. 617 of 1940 is hereby cancelled.
