NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL.- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

PAPAVERIN. Order of the Ministry of the Interior dated 9 November 1961 annulling the Order of 31 January 1941 (Official Journal of 2 February) and declaring the trade in and distribution of papaverin and its salts to be free.

Since the reasons for issuing the Order of 31 January 1941 (Official Journal of 2 February) no longer exist, and in the light of the fact that papaverin and its salts are not included in the lists contained in the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs which was adopted this year in New York and signed by the Spanish Government,

This Ministry has decided to annul the previous Order and to declare the trade in and distribution of papaverin and its salts to be free.
