Note by the Secretary-General.

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of the United Kingdom.

THE PHARMACY AND POISONS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1947

(1947 Ordinance No. 17)

An ordinance to amend the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance 1939.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Governor-General of the Sudan in Council as follows:

1. This ordinance may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) Ordinance 1947 and shall come into force on publication in the Sudan Government Gazette.

Title and commencement. (15.7.1947)

2. The Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance 1939 as amended by the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) Ordinance 1946 is hereby further amended as follows:

Amendment

Sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of subsection (i) of section 19 is repealed and the following sub-paragraph is substituted therefor:

- "(i) the technical management of the pharmacy is under the sole control of a licensed pharmacist."
