Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of the United Kingdom.

THE POISONS (AMENDMENT) NO. 2 ORDER 1948  
(1948 LRO No. 39)

In exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 23 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, 1939, the Central Board of Public Health hereby make the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the Poisons (Amendment) No. 2 Order 1948 and shall come into force on publication in the Sudan Government Gazette.
2. The Poisons (Amendment) Order 1946 (1946 L.R.O. No. 38) is hereby cancelled.
3. The Poisons Order 1939 is hereby amended as follows:  
In Part 1 of the Poisons List:
  - (a) the words "and Pethedine" shall be added at the end of item (j).
  - (b) There shall be inserted in item (k) after the words "methyilmorphine (commonly known as Codeine)" the words "containing not less than 1 per cent, of methyilmorphine."
