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#### CONTROL OF NARCOTIC DRUGS

Preparations manufactured from or containing the substances and preparations specified in this list are also deemed to be narcotic drugs.

### Group C

Other substances capable of producing addiction and harmful effects similar to those of morphine, cocaine and hashish.

(8) Mixtures and solutions (other than solutions for injection) containing not more than 0.1 per cent of cocaine (calculated as a base) which are suitable for normal medical application are exempted from control.

List of substances and preparations exempted by the Federal Council from the narcotic drugs control

1. Pulvis Ipecacuanhae opiatus (Pulvis Doveri). Pulvis Ipecacuanhae opiatus solubilis (Pulvis Doveri solubilis).

2. Mixtures and solutions (other than solutions for injection) containing not more than 0.2 per cent of morphine or not more than 0.1 per cent of cocaine (calculated as a base) and suitable for normal medical application, as for example solutions, pills, malt extract tablets and malt syrup of Ipecopan.
3. Preparations containing not less than 10 per cent of Pentetrazol (Pentazolium) and not more than 0.5 per cent of dihydrocodeinone salt.
4. Preparations containing codeine, ethylmorphine, dihydrocodeine, acetyl-dihydrocodeine, thebaine and their salts and used for normal medical application.

List of substances which under the Federal Narcotic Drugs Act must not be imported, manufactured or dealt in commercially in any form

Raw opium and the residue left from the production or use of raw opium. Diacetylmorphine and its salts.
