PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL TREATIES ON NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES

THAILAND

Communicated by the Government of Thailand

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY GENERAL – In accordance with the relevant Articles of the International Treaties on Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative texts.

Ministerial Regulation

No. 1 (B.E. 2520)

Issued under the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E. 2518 1/

By virtue of Section 5, Section 21, Section 30 and Section 62 of the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E. 2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

Clause 1. Any person wishing to apply for a licence to possess or utilize any psychotropic substance shall submit an application in the form PU.S. 1 attached hereto together with evidences as specified therein.

Clause 2. A grantor may grant a licence to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance when the aim of the applicant in possessing or utilizing the psychotropic substance is for medical or scientific purposes only and the grantor deems it expedient.

Clause 3. The licence to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance shall be in the form PU.S. 2 attached hereto.

Clause 4. A licensee to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance shall keep a record of its acquisition and disposal showing the production serial number or letter, name, quantity as well as date of every acquisition and disposal thereof.

Clause 5. Any licensee to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance wishing to renew the licence shall submit an application in the form PU.S. 3 attached hereto.

In granting renewal of a licence to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance, the grantor may include the particulars of renewal on the existing licence or issue a new licence in the form PU.S. 2.

Clause 6. Any licensee to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance wishing to apply for a licence substitute shall submit an application in the form PU.S. 4 attached hereto.

In granting the licence substitute, the grantor shall issue a licence in the form PU.S. 2 with the word "Substitute" printed on the front.

Clause 7. For Bangkok Metropolis, the submission of application under the Ministerial Regulation shall be made at the Office of Food and Drug Board, Ministry of Public Health; for other Changwat, at Changwat Public Health Office.

Clause 8. The fees shall be levied as follows:

(1)	Licence to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance	100 Baht each
(2)	Licence substitute	50 Baht each
(3)	Renewal of licence	100 Baht each

Ministerial Regulation

No. 2 (B.E. 2520)

Issued under the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E.25181/

By virtue of Section 5, Section 16, Section 21, Section 27, Section 30, Section 32 and Section 33 of the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E. 2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

Clause 1. Any person wishing to apply for a licence to produce a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall submit an application in the form P.S.l and the forms attached to the form P.S.l attached hereto together with evidence specified therein, and plan of the place of production and storage of the psychotropic substance.

Clause 2. An applicant for licence to produce a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV in any chapter under the law on drugs, must also be a licensee to produce drugs under such chapter, and must have place of production, storage, production equipment and proper quality control as specified by the law on drugs and must also have measures to prevent drugs or other substances from mixing with psychotropic substance during the production process.

Clause 3. A licence to produce a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall be in the form P.S.3 attached hereto.

Clause 4. A licensee to produce a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV must comply with the following:

(1) provide a durable sign of the size 15 x 60 centimetres, containing statement in Thai "Place of Production of Psychotropic Substance" using letters not smaller than 3 centimetres;

(2) keep a record of the acquisition and disposal of the psychotropic substance used as raw material in the production, showing name of producer, production source, production serial number or letter, evidence of quality and standard analysis, name and quantity of psychotropic substance as well as the date of every acquisition and disposal;

(3) keep a record of every type of psychotropic substance produced each time and a sales record of the psychotropic substance, showing the production serial number or letter, evidence of quality and standard analysis, name and quantity of psychotropic substance, as well as the date of production or sale. The sales record of the psychotropic substance is not required to show the evidence of quality and standard analysis but it must show the name and address of the buyer;

(4) keep a sample of the psychotropic substance produced each time in sufficient quantity for the quality and standard analysis for not less than two years.

Clause 5. A pharmacist having the duty to supervise the production of psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV must comply with the following:

(1) carry out supervision to ensure proper compliance with Clause 2;

(2) supervise the keeping of records of acquisition and disposal of psychotropic substances under Clause 4 (2) and (3) by examining and certifying the record and affixing signature thereto;

(3) provide durable sign of the name of the pharmacist, with the name and qualification in Thai, using letters not smaller than two centimetres in height and such sign shall be displayed in a conspicuous place at the place of production of the psychotropic substance.

Clause 6. Any licensee to produce psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to renew the licence shall submit an application in the form P.S. 3 attached hereto.

In granting the renewal of a licence to produce psychotropic substances, the grantor may include the particulars of renewal on the existing licence or issue a new licence in the form P.S.2.

Clause 7. Any licensee to produce a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to apply for a licence substitute shall submit an application in the form P.S.4 attached hereto.

In granting the licence substitute, the grantor shall issue a licence in the form P.S.2 with the word "Substitute" printed on the front.

Clause 8. Any licensee to produce a psychotropic substance wishing to move, alter or expand the place of production or storage of psychotropic substances shall submit an application in the form P.S.5 attached hereto together with a plan of the new place of production or storage and the licence to produce such substances.

In granting permission for the licensee to move, alter or expand the place of production or storage of psychotropic substances, the grantor shall include the particulars thereof on the licence.

Clause 9. For Bangkok Metropolis, the submission of applications under this Ministerial Regulation shall be made at the Drug Control Division, Office of Food and Drug Board, Ministry of Public Health; for other Changwat, at the Changwat Public Health Office.

Clause 10. The fees shall be levied as follows:

Issued under the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E. 25181/

By virtue of Section 5, Section 16, Section 21, Section 28, Section 30, Section 32 and Section 34 of the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E. 2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

Clause 1. Any person who wishes to apply for a licence to sell a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall submit an application in the form S.S.l attached hereto, together with evidence as specified therein and the plan of the place of sale of the psychotropic substance.

Clause 2. An applicant for a licence to sell a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV must be a licensee to sell modern drugs under the law on drugs and must have a place to sell, selling implements and proper quality control as specified by the law on drugs, as well as have measures to prevent drugs or other substances from mixing with the sale of psychotropic substances.

Clause 3. A licence to sell psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall be in the form S_*S_*2 attached hereto.

Clause 4. A licensee to sell psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall comply with the following:

(1) provide a durable sign, size 15 x 60 centimetres, containing statement in Thai "Place of sale of psychotropic substances" using letters not smaller than 3 centimetres;

(2) keep a record of each type of psychotropic substance sold each time on prescription which is issued by medical practitioner, first-class practitioner in the branch of dentistry or first-class veterinarian, showing name, age and address of patient or animal receiving the treatment of prevention, name and address or office of the issuer, name, production serial number or letter and quantity as well as date of each sale.

The prescription must be kept for not less than two years;

(3) keep a record of purchase of each type of psychotropic substance showing the source of purchase, production serial number or letter, name and quantity as well as the date of each purchase.

Clause 5. The pharmacist having the duty to supervise the sale of psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall comply with the following:

(1) carry out supervision to ensure proper compliance under Clause 2;

(2) supervise the proper keeping of records under Clause 4 (2) and (3) and certify the records by affixing his signature thereto;

(3) provide durable sign of the name of pharmacist containing name and qualification in Thai letters which must not be smaller than 2 centimetres and such sign must be displayed conspicuously at the place of sale of psychotropic substance;

(4) advise the person buying psychotropic substances from a licensee in connexion with the use thereof according to the principles and professional etiquette.

Clause 6. Any licensee to sell psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to renew the licence shall submit an application in the form S.S.3 attached hereto.

In granting renewal of licence to sell psychotropic substance, the grantor may include particulars thereof on the licence or may issue a new licence in the form S.S.2. Clause 7. Any licensee to sell a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to apply for a licence substitute shall submit an application on the form S.S.4 attached hereto.

In granting the licence substitute, the grantor shall issue a licence on the form S.S.2 with the word "Substitute" printed on the front.

Clause 8. Any licensee to sell psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to move, alter or expand the place of sale of psychotropic substances shall submit an application on the form S.S.5 attached hereto together with a plan of the new place of sale and licence to sell psychotropic substances.

In granting permission for the licensee to move, alter or expand the place of sale of psychotropic substances the grantor shall include the particulars of the granting thereof on the licence.

Clause 9. For Bangkok Metropolis, the submission of applications under this Ministerial Regulation shall be made to the Drug Control Division, Office of Food and Drug Board, Ministry of Public Health; for other Changwat, at the Changwat Public Health Office.

By virtue of Section 5, Section 16, Section 21, Section 29, Section 30, Section 32 and Section 35 of the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E. 2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Notification:

Clause 1. Any person wishing to apply for a licence to import psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall submit an application in the form LS.1 attached hereto, together with evidences as specified therein.

Clause 2. An applicant for a licence to import psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV must be a licensee to import or order modern drugs into the Kingdom under the law on drugs and must have a storage place and proper quality control as specified by the law on drugs.

Clause 3. A licence to import psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall be in the form LS.2 attached hereto.

Clause 4. A licencee to import psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV shall comply with the following:

(1) provide a durable sign of the size 15 x 60 centimetres, containing statement in Thai "Place of Import of Psychotropic Substance" using letters not smaller than 3 centimetres;

(2) keep record of the import of each psychotropic substance, showing the trade name, name of producer, production source, production serial number or letter, evidence of quality and standard analysis, place of import and the quantity as well as the date of each import;

(3) keep record of each sale of psychotropic substances showing the production serial number or letter, trade name and quantity of psychotropic substance, name and address of buyer as well as the date of each sale;

(4) keep sample of each psychotropic substance imported in sufficient quantity for the quality and standard analysis for not less than two years.

Clause 5. A pharmacist having the duty to supervise the import of psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV must comply with the following:

(1) carry out supervision to ensure proper compliance with Clause 4;

(2) supervise the keeping of records under Clause 4 (2) and (3) by examining the record and affixing signature thereto;

(3) provide durable sign of the name of the pharmacist with the name and qualification in Thai using letter not smaller than two centimetres in height and such sign shall be displayed conspicuously at the place of import of the psychotropic substance.

Clause 6. Any licensee to import psychotropic substances in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to renew the licence shall submit an application in the form LS.3 attached hereto.

In granting the renewal of a licence to import psychotropic substances, the grantor may include the particulars of renewal on the licence or issue a new licence in the form LS.2

Clause 7. Any licensee to import a psychotropic substance in Schedule III or Schedule IV wishing to apply for a licence substitute shall submit an application in the form LS.4 attached hereto.

Clause 3. A licence to import a psychotropic substance in Schedule II shall be in the form L.B.S.2 attached hereto.

Clause 4. A licence to export psychotropic substances in Schedule II shall be in the form L.E.S.3 attached hereto.

Clause 5. A licensee must display the licence issued under Clause 3 or Clause 4 on the carrier for inspection by officials.

Clause 6. Any licensee wishing to apply for a licence substitute under Clause 3 or Clause 4 shall submit an application in the form L.E.S.4 attached hereto.

In granting a licence substitute, the grantor shall issue a licence in the form L.E.S.2 or L.E.S.3, as the case may be, with the word "Substitute" printed on the front.

Clause 7. The submission of applications under this Ministerial Regulation shall be made to the Drug Control Division, Office of Food and Drug Board, Ministry of Public Health.

Clause 8. The licensee to import or export psychotropic substance in Schedule II under this Ministerial Regulation shall be regarded as licensee to possess or utilize psychotropic substance in Schedule II which has been granted import or export permission in the permitted carrier.

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 70 of the Psychotropic Substance Act, B.E.2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

Clause 1. Any person who has been authorized by the Ministry of Public Health wishing to apply for a temporary licence to import or export psychotropic substances in Schedule I or Schedule II shall submit an application for each import or export of psychotropic substance in the form T.S.l attached hereto together with the evidence specified therein.

Clause 2. An applicant for a temporary licence to export psychotropic substances in Schedule I or Schedule II must bring the licence to import issued by the exporting country to the Ministry of Public Health at the Drug Control Division. Office of Food and Drug Board, Ministry of Public Health.

Clause 3. Temporary licence to import a psychotropic substance in Schedule I or Schedule II shall be in the form T.S.2 attached hereto.

Clause 4. Temporary licence to export a psychotropic substance in Schedule I or Schedule II shall be in the form T.S.3 attached hereto.

Clause 5. Licence under Clause 3 or Clause 4 must be accompanied by five copies each of which must be numbered as follows:

(1) Copy of licence, No. 1;

(2) Copy of licence, No. 2;

(3) Copy of licence, No. 3;

(4) Copy of licence, No. 4;

(5) Copy of licence, No. 5.

Copy of licence No. 1 shall be signed by the Secretary-General of the Food and Drug Board.

Copies of licence No. 2 to No. 5 shall be signed by the officials.

Clause 6. The Office of Food and Drug Board shall proceed with the temporary licence to import psychotropic substances in Schedule I or Schedule II and the said copies under Clause 5 in the following manners:

(1) The licence shall be returned to the licensee to be dispatched to the competent authority of the exporting country.

(2) Copy of licence No. 1 shall be given to the licensee to be kept as evidence.

(3) Copies of licence No. 2 and No. 3 shall be sent to the Customs Department.

When the psychotropic substance under the licence has been imported, the Customs Department shall endorse the copy of licence No. 3 and send it to the Office of Food and Drug Board. The Customs Department shall keep the copy of licence No. 2 as evidence.

(4) Copies of licence No. 4 and No. 5 shall be kept by the Office of Food and Drug Board as evidence.

Clause 2. The Office of Food and Drug Board shall proceed with the temporary licence to export psychotropic substances in Schedule I or Schedule II and the said copies under Clause 5 in the following manners:

(1) The licence shall be returned to the licensee to be kept as evidence.

(2) Copy of licence No. 1 shall be given to the licensee to be dispatched with the psychotropic substance to be exported.

(3) Copies of licence No. 2 and No. 3 shall be sent to the competent authority of the importing country.

(4) Copy of licence No. 4 shall be sent by the Office of Food and Drug Board to the Customs Department for use as evidence for inspection.

(5) Copy of licence No. 5 shall be kept by the Office of Food and Drug Board as evidence.

Clause 8. The kind and quantity of psychotropic substance permitted to be imported under temporary licence must not exceed the number and quantity specified in the licence.

Clause 9. The kind and quality of psychotropic substance permitted to be exported under temporary licence must not exceed the number and quantity specified in the licence.

Clause 10. The submission of applications under this Ministerial Regulation shall be made to the Drug Control Division, Office of Food and Drug Board, Ministry of Public Health.

Clause 11. The fee for temporary licence to import or export psychotropic substances in Schedule I or Schedule II shall be exempted.

(3) compliance in connexion with the import of psychotropic substances in Schedule II under Section 71 of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518;

(4) compliance in connexion with the export of psychotropic substances in Schedule II under Section 73 of the psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518;

(5) compliance in connexion with carrying in transit a psychotropic substance in Schedule II under Section 74 of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518;

(6) compliance in connexion with import of a psychotropic substance in Schedule III under Section 80 of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518;

(7) compliance in connexion with each export of psychotropic substances in Schedule III under Section 82 of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518;

(8) requirement to have warning or caution in connexion with psychotropic substances under the Notification of the Minister pursuant to Section 6(5) of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518.

Ministerial Regulation

No. 14 (B.E. 2520)

Issued under the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 25181/

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 27 (3) of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulations:

Clause 1. The label which is affixed to the psychotropic substance, container or package may display any lettering, figure, artificial mark or wording.

Clause 2. Label and accompanied leaflet of psychotropic substance must contain the following warning:

"Warning: This psychotropic substance may be harmful habit forming, and may only be taken under doctor's order".

The letters of the warning shall be in red but those on accompanied leaflets may be in any colour, provided the description and size is clear and is more prominent than other wording appearing thereon, as the case may be, except for the name of the preparation.

Clause 3. The label must contain at least the following:

(1) Name of the preparation;

(2) Quantity of preparation;

(3) Name and quantity of psychotropic substance and other medicinal ingredients contained in the preparation.

- (4) Either or both serial numbers or letters of production or analysis;
- (5) Number of the certificate of registration of preparation issued by officials;
- (6) Name of producer and address of the place of production;
- (7) The word "Psychotropic Substance" in red so as to be clearly visible;
- (8) Expiry date of the preparation if it expires according to the nature;
- (9) Warning as specified in Clause 2.

Clause 4. Where the psychotropic substance is packed in a container and there is a package, a label must also be displayed thereon. However, if the container or package is too small for such display as specified under Clause 3, the label shall be displayed on the container and it must contain at least the following particulars:

- (1) The word "Psychotropic Substance" in red so as to be clearly visible;
- (2) Name and quantity of psychotropic substance contained in the preparation;
- (3) Number of the certificate of registration of preparation issued by officials;
- (4) Expiry date of the preparation if it expires according to the nature.

Clause 5. Accompanied leaflet of a psychotropic substance may be inserted or included in the container or package by separating it from the label.

Clause 6. In case there is a caution on usage of a psychotropic substance, the caution shall clearly appear on the label or accompanied leaflet of the psychotropic substance.

Clause 7. Label, accompanied leaflet, warning or caution on usage of psychotropic substance must contain statement in Thai language. If foreign language is also included, such statement in the foreign language must not conflict with the statement in Thai language.

Clause 8. Labels or accompanied leaflets of psychotropic statement must comply with those registered with the preparation.

Ministerial Regulation

No. 15 (B.E. 2520)

Issued under the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 25181/

By virtue of Section 4, Section 67, Section 68 and Section 87 of the Psychotropic Substances. Act, B.E. 2518, the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

Records of acquisition and disposal of psychotropic substances and reports under Section 87 shall be in the form Re.S. 1, Re.S. 2, Re.S. 3, Re.S. 4, Re.S. 5, Re.S. 6, Re.S. 7, Re.S. 8, Re.S. 9, and Re.S. 10 attached hereto under the following procedures:

(1) For a licensee to produce a psychotropic substance, the acquisition and disposal of the psychotropic substance used as raw material in the production shall be in the form Re.S. 1, the production thereof shall be in the form Re.S. 2 and the sale thereof shall be in the form Re.S.3.

(2) For a licensee to sell a psychotropic substance, the purchase thereof shall be in the form Re.S. 4 and the sale thereof shall be in the form Re.S. 5.

(3) For a licensee to import psychotropic substances, the sale thereof shall be in the form Re.S. 3 and the import thereof in the form Re.S.6.

(4) For a licensee to export a psychotropic substance, form Re.S. 7 shall be used.

(5) For a licensee to possess or utilize a psychotropic substance, form Re.S. 8 shall be used.

(6) For a person who is required to submit a report to the Secretary-General under Section 87 of the Psychotropic Substances Act, B.E. 2518, the monthly report shall be in the form Re.S. 9 and annual report shall be in the form Re.S. 10.



Clause 1. The identity card of officials shall be in the form attached hereto.


Clause 2. The photograph to be affixed to the identity card shall be half length, full face without hat of the size 3×4 centimetres.
