Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to forward to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention the following law communicated by the Government of Transjordan.

Dangerous Drugs-Ordinance to amend Dangerous Drugs
Law (No.4 of 1937) Law No.28 of 1947

We, Abdullah Ibn El Hussein, King of the Hashimite Kingdom of Transjordan, in accordance with article 53 of the Constitution and in pursuance of the decision of the Council of Ministers at its meeting held on 3.8.47 approve in accordance with article 28 of the Constitution the following ordinance and order the issue thereof:

Law No.28 of 1947

An Ordinance to amend the Dangerous Drugs Law (No. 4 of 1937)

1. The following paragraph is added to article 16 of the Dangerous Drugs Law (No. 4 of 1937):
"The Prime Minister may order to pay as a reward to any person giving information or performing any act leading to the detection of an offence under this law or to the confiscation of any dangerous drugs such amount as he may think fit."
2. This Ordinance shall come into force from the date of its Publication in the Official Gazette.
3. The Prime Minister and the Minister of Finance and Economics are charged with the execution of this law.
