In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate hereafter the text of a law.

Act ratifying the Paris Protocol bringing under international control drugs outside the scope of the Geneva Convention, as amended by the Protocol signed in New York on 11 December 1946.

Act. No. 5575

Date of passage: 1 March 1950

Date of publication: 4 March 1950

Article 1. The Paris Protocol of 19 November 1948 bringing under international control drugs scientifically established to be capable of producing addiction but outside the scope of the Geneva Convention of 13 July 1931 for limiting the manufacture and regulating the distribution of narcotic drugs, as amended by the Protocol signed in New York on 11 December 1946, is hereby ratified.

Article 2. This Act shall enter into force on the date of its publication.

Article 3. The Council of Ministers shall be responsible for the execution of the provisions of this Act.
