DECREE No. 6/8409

- 1. Designation of districts where poppy cultivation and opium gum production will be permitted for 1967-1968 cultivation year (Table I).

DECREE No. 6/9123

In accordance with article 3 (1) and (2) of Act No. 244 of 31 May 1963, and pursuant to communication 722.201-BNKY/1-58, dated 24 October 1967, of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Council of Ministers, on 16 November 1967, has ordered the amendments shown in the attached list to be made in the schedules of drugs annexed to the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961, approved for application by Turkey by the National Assembly by Act No. 812 of 27 December 1966, which was ordered by the Council of Ministers on 14 February 1967 to be given effect and was published in the Official Gazette by Decree No. 6/7732 of 12 May 1967.

Amendments to be made in certain drugs listed in schedule III of the Single Convention of 1961 annexed to Decree No. 6/9123 of 16 November 1967

1. Combine paragraph 1 (a) and (b) of schedule III to read as follows:

"Compounded with one or more other ingredients and containing not more than 100 milligrammes of the drug per dosage unit and with a concentration of not more than 2.5 per cent in undivided preparations".

2. In paragraph 2 of schedule III, delete the phrase "In such a way that the preparation has no, or a negligible, risk of abuse, and" so that the paragraph reads as follows:

"Preparations of cocaine containing not more than 0.1 per cent of cocaine calculated as cocaine base and preparations of opium or morphine containing not more than 0.2 per cent of morphine calculated as anhydrous morphine base and compounded with one or more other ingredients in such a way that the drug cannot be recovered by readily applicable means or any yield which would constitute a risk to public health".

3. In paragraph 3 of schedule III delete the words "solid dose", so that the text will read as follows:

"Preparations of diphenoxylate containing not more than 2.5 milligrammes of diphenoxylate calculated as base and not less than 25 microgrammes of atropine sulphate per dosage unit".

Additions and deletions to be made in the schedules annexed to the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs. 1961

1. The following drugs shall be added to schedule I:

"1-(3 cyano-3,3-diphenylpropyl)-4-(1-piperidino)-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid amide" (proposed standard international designation: piritramide)2/ and salts thereof.

- 2. The following drugs shall be added to schedule I:
 - Drugs M.183 and M.99 (proposed standard international designations: acetorphine and etorphine).
- 3. The following drug is not to be included in any of the lists of the Convention:
 "Drug M.285 (proposed standard international designation: cyprenorphine)".
- 4. The following drug shall be added to schedule I and shall be subject to control:

"Dihydrocodeinone-6-carboxymethyloxime, for which the international designation "codoxime" has been adopted".
