PROMULGATED TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION OF 13 JULY 1931 FOR LIMITING THE MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS, AS AMENDED BY THE PROTOCOL OF 11 DECEMBER 1946

NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL-- In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

RESOLUTION NO. 94

Republic of Venezuela - Ministry of Health and Public Assistance
Department of Public Health - Pharmaceutical Division
Caracas, 8 August 1960 - 151st and 102nd

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

That inasmuch as codeine and its salts are addiction-producing drugs derived from opium, they are, in accordance with the provisions of article 1 of the Narcotic Drugs Act currently in force, subject to the application of the said Act, and, pursuant to the provisions of articles 41 and 42 thereof, this Office has decided to subject the sale of these drugs in injectable pharmaceutical form to the provisions of article 1 of the Narcotic Drugs Act, i.e. they may be sold only against prescriptions on special forms issued by the Ministry of Health and Public Assistance.
