#### NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 13 July 1931 for Limiting the Manufacture and Regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following legislative text.

ORDER No. 3 YTS/PC of 15 Februar 1952 concerning the inclusion of isodianisyl ethanolamine and its salts in Schedule A (poisonous substances)

The MINISTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH

considering . . . . .

### Orders as follows:

Article I. Isodianisyl ethanolamine and its salts shall be deleted from Schedule B (narcotic substances) of the Decree of 26 July 1949 and shall be included in Schedule A (poisonous substances) of the same Decree.

Article 2. The Director of the office of the Minister of Public Health and the Director-General of Health and Hospitals shall be responsible, so far as each is concerned, for giving effect to this Order.
