ORDER No. 3 YTS/PC of 15 February 1952 concerning
the inclusion of isodianisyl ethanolamine and its salts
in Schedule A (poisonous substances)

The MINISTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH

considering

Orders as follows:

Article 1. Isodianisyl ethanolamine and its salts shall
be deleted from Schedule B (narcotic substances) of the
Decree of 26 July 1949 and shall be included in Sched-
ule A (poisonous substances) of the same Decree.

Article 2. The Director of the office of the Minister
of Public Health and the Director-General of Health and
Hospitals shall be responsible, so far as each is con-
cerned, for giving effect to this Order.
