THE DANGEROUS DRUGS DECREE

The Dangerous Drugs Order, 1956.

- Cap. 64 In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2A of the Dangerous Drugs Decree, and otherwise, His Highness the Sultan in Executive Council is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Order:-
 - 1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs Order, 1956.
 - 2. The drugs set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be dangerous drugs within the provisions of the Dangerous Drugs Decree.
 - 3. The definition of the expression "dangerous drugs" in section 2 of the Dangerous Drugs Decree is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the drugs set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Alphamethadol¹⁾, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of alphamethadol.

Betamethadol, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of betamethadol.

Alphacetylmethadol, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of alphacethylmethadol.

Betacetylmethadol, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of betacethylmethadol.

Dimethylthiambutene, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dimethylthiambutene.

Dimethylthiambutene, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dimethylthiambutene.

<u>Dipipanone</u>, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other subtance containing any proportion of dipipanone.

1-methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-carboxylic acid isopropyl ester /Properidine/, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 1-methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid isopropyl ester.

Ethylmethylthiambutene, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of ethylmethylthiambutene.

Methyldihydromorphine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of methyldihydromorphine.

Normethadone, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of normethadone.

Oxymorphone, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of oxymorphone.

Myristyl ester of benzylmorphine / Myrophine /, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of myristyl ester of benzylmorphine.
