The Council Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations, acting in accordance with Council resolution 228 B (X) met at the European Office of the United Nations on 1 July, under the Chairmanship of Miss Jeanne Pelt (Netherlands), to consider the applications of non-governmental organizations in category A consultative status to be heard by the Council or its Committees under rules 85 and 86.
