The Republic of Belarus and Solomon Islands,


Desiring to promote and strengthen ties of friendship and cooperation between their countries and peoples on the basis of equality, mutual respect for sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity as well as non-interference in the internal affairs of each of the states,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations, as well as the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961 and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the Republic of Belarus and Solomon Islands as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

Done in New York on September 10, 2012 in duplicate in the Belarusian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.



Solomon Islands and the Republic of Belarus,


