

INTRODUCTION

This statistical summary provides basic trade and payments series for the countries of Western Asia for the nineteen sixties and the early years of the nineteen seventies. The tables were compiled from national and international sources. The series provide a picture of the trend in aggregate trade, in both national currency units and United States dollars, the geographical and commodity distribution of trade, intraregional trade flows, and the payments and reserve position of member countries.

Explanatory Notes

Trade classification

Trade flows are presented according to the Standard International Trade Classification, Revised (SITC, Revised).^{1/} However, the conversion to SITC, from the national commodity classification in the case of Dubai of the United Arab Emirates, and from the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature (BTN), in the case of Lebanon and Saudi Arabia, could not be done precisely and, therefore, some of the SITC classes are not exact in their coverage. Trade in monetary gold whether in the form of bullion, coins, unrefined, partly worked, rolled, waste and sweepings is accordingly excluded from both exports and imports. Unless otherwise mentioned, ammunition, bunkers, stores for ships and aircrafts are also excluded.

Systems of trade

(a) Special trade:

Imports are the combined total of imports directly for domestic consumption (including transformation and repair) and withdrawals from bonded warehouses or free zones for domestic consumption.

Exports comprise exports of national merchandise, namely, goods wholly or partly produced or manufactured in the country, together with exports of nationalized goods. The latter are goods which, having been included in special imports, are then exported without transformation.

(b) General trade:

Imports are the combined total of imports directly for domestic consumption and imports into a bonded warehouse or free zone.

Exports are the combined total of national exports and re-exports. Re-exports, in the general trade system, consist of the outward movement of nationalized goods plus goods which, after importation, move outward from a bonded warehouse or free zone without having been transformed.

Valuation

Imports are valued c.i.f. - the value at which the goods were purchased by the importer plus the cost of transportation and insurance to the frontier of the importing country. Exports are valued f.o.b. - the value at which the goods were sold by the exporter including the cost of transportation and insurance to bring the goods onto the carrier at the frontier of the exporting country.

Currency conversion

Conversion from national currencies to United States dollars is done by means of currency conversion factors calculated by the International Monetary Fund on the basis of official exchange rates (mainly par values and central rates). Values in currencies subject to fluctuation^{1/} are converted into United States dollars using weighted average exchange rates: the exchange rate, or the simple average rate in effect during each month weighted by the corresponding monthly trade returns.
