JOINT COMMUNIQUE

on the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Kingdom of Bhutan

The Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Royal Government of Bhutan,

Desirous to promote mutual understanding and cooperation between their two Peoples, and guided by the Charter of the United Nations and generally accepted norms and principles of international law, in particular those relating to sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961, as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué,

Done in New York on 7 February 2013, each one in Azerbaijani, Dzongkha and English languages. All texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation of the Joint Communiqué, the English text will prevail.
