OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR DEVELOPMENT

ACTIVITIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 1240 B (XIII) of 14 October 1958, the reports of the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme on its ninth and tenth sessions^{1/} are before the General Assembly. The Economic and Social Council, which considered the reports at its forty-ninth session, took note of them in resolution 1529 (XLIX). The Economic and Social Council also adopted resolution 1530 (XLIX) referred to in paragraph 3 below. A summary of the discussion in the Economic and Social Council on the work of UNDP is contained in chapter X, section A, of its annual report to the General Assembly.^{2/}
2. The budget estimates of UNDP for 1970 (DP/L.114 and Add.1), which were approved by the Governing Council at its ninth session, are also available to the General Assembly. When approving the estimates, the Governing Council took into account the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions to the General Assembly at its twenty-fourth session.^{3/}
3. The Economic and Social Council, after considering the parts of the reports of the Governing Council of UNDP concerning the capacity of the United Nations development system, adopted resolution 1530 (XLIX) in which it recommended a draft resolution for adoption by the General Assembly. Economic and Social Council resolution 1530 (XLIX) has been issued under the symbol A/C.2/L.1102.
