SECOND UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT DECADE

Report of the Second Committee (part II)

Rapporteur: Mr. Leandro I. VERCELES (Philippines)

1. The Committee discussed the procedure for review and appraisal of progress in the implementation of the International Development Strategy for the Second United Nations Development Decade at its 1316th and 1317th meetings on 20 October 1970 and its 1338th meeting on 10 November 1970. The Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs made an introductory statement at the 1316th meeting.^{1/}
2. At the 1338th meeting, the representative of India, on behalf of Argentina, Brazil, France, India, Indonesia, Italy, Morocco, the Netherlands, Pakistan, the Philippines, the Sudan and Yugoslavia, introduced a draft resolution relating to the review and appraisal of the objectives and policies of the International Development Strategy (A/C.2/L.1117). At the same meeting, Greece, Kenya, Madagascar and the United States of America joined in sponsoring the draft resolution.
3. During the discussion of the draft resolution, the sponsors accepted a suggestion by the representative of Greece to use the expression "United Nations family", in operative paragraphs 3 and 4, instead of "United Nations system" which appeared in the original text (A/C.2/L.1117).
4. At its 1338th meeting, the Committee adopted, without objection, the sixteen-Power draft resolution (A/C.2/L.1117) as orally revised.
