ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 7 December 1966 from the President of the Security Council  
to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution on the admission of Barbados to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1330th meeting on 7 December 1966:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Barbados for admission to the United Nations,

"Recommends to the General Assembly that Barbados be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim record of the 1330th meeting of the Security Council, at which the application of Barbados was discussed.
